**Old Business**: L. Donnelly, 1375 NY-9; applicant provided APA documents and verification of underground tank removal.

New Business: 3 Garrison Way, area variance

Area variance request for onsite wastewater disposal system that is proposed to be installed within the setback area. This is a replacement system. NYS DOH does not require a waiver for this system (per T. Hutchins PE).

Proposed setbacks are as follows (per stamped plan):

Tank to property line (10' required), 6' relief to 4'

Tank to house (10' required), 5' relief to 5'

Effluent line to property line (10' required), 8' relief to 2'

- T. Hutchins explains the project and shares the stamped plan. There are no separation distance issues for either the lake or drilled wells (applicant or neighbors). Variance request is purely for 10' Town setback to property line.
